vided into specific sub-categories. The title of the "Leader of Polish Ecology" and one distinction is awarded in each sub-category. In special cases the Minister of Environment may award more awards and distinctions.

Projects and solutions submitted by entrants competing for the title "Leader of Polish Ecology" must meet such criteria as ecological and social impact, economic effectiveness, universality in applications, solution uniqueness and innovation.

Since 2005, laureates of the two last competitions and prize winners of the Clean Business Programme are eligible to take part in the Polish edition of the "European Business Awards for the Environment" competition. Among them eight candidates will be selected and recommended to the European competition. The "European Business Awards for the Environment" are awarded every two years by the European Commission. The competition was established in 1987 to stimulate technological innovations advancing sustainable development. Only companies who won a national competition are eligible to enter the European event.
